NOTIFIABLE PLANT PEST (CITRUS CANKER AND CITRUS LEPROSIS) ORDER

[29th June, 2002.]

Short title.

1. This Order may be cited as the

NOTIFIABLE PLANT PESTS (CITRUS CANKER AND CITRUS LEPROSIS) ORDER.

Notifiable plant pests. CAP. 211. It is hereby notified and declared that Citrus Canker and Citrus Leprosis
are notifiable plant pests for the purposes of section 35 (a) and (f) of the Belize
Agricultural Health Authority Act.

Restrictions on sale, etc., of restricted articles. A person shall -

- immediately notify the Belize Agricultural Health Authority of the presence or suspected presence of Citrus Canker or Citrus Leprosis in any area;
- not possess, carry or import wooden pallets made from Citrus Canker from infested areas;
- (c) not possess, carry or import citrus products or plant parts from infested areas without the prior written approval of the Belize Agricultural Health Authority.

Commencement. 4. This Order shall come into force on the 15th day of March, 2002.
