

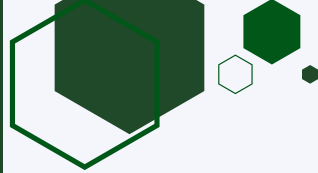

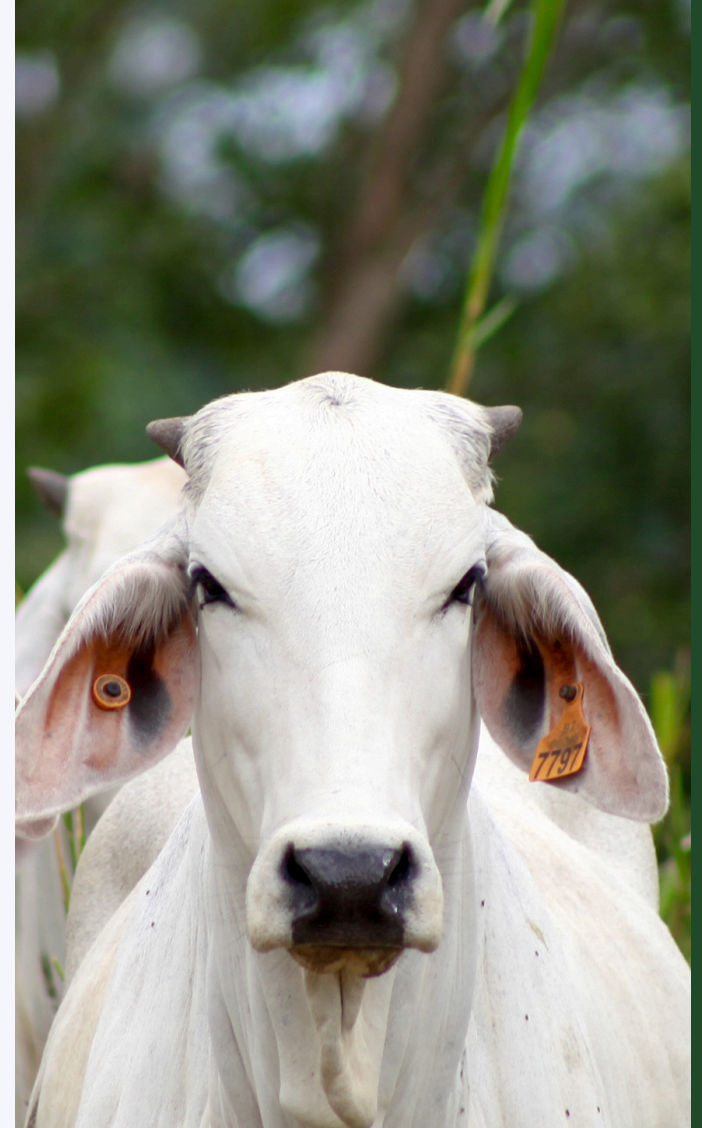

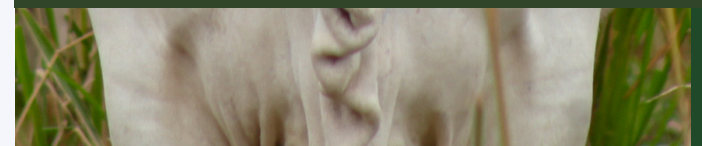

CATTLE VACCINATION





IMPORTANCE OF VACCINATION

Disease Protection!



Vaccination protects your livestock from diseases.



Vaccination helps to prevent or fight off diseases more effectively.



Vaccination protects your animal from deadly and preventable diseases such as Rabies and Blackleg.

PRESERVING VACCINES

- Maintain the cold chain to ensure efficacy of the vaccine.
- Store in temperatures ranging from 35°F (2°C) to 45°F (8°C) and according to the label.
- Use only registered or approved vaccines.
- Vaccines can be easily acquired and come as individual vials or multi-dose bottles.

DO NOT FREEZE!

WHEN BEST TO VACCINATE?

The best time to vaccinate depends on what you are vaccinating against.

- Rabies:
 - Administer vaccine at 2 months of age. Follow with a booster at 3 and 6 months.
 - Annual revaccination is recommended in adult cattle.
- Blackleg:
 - Administer vaccine at 2 months of age. Follow with a booster at 4 months.
 - Annual revaccination is recommended in adult cattle.
